 § 11-0540. Prohibition on the issuance of permits authorizing the use of

 wild animals and elephants in circuses.

5 <u>1. The department shall not issue a permit or license, including, but</u> 6 <u>not limited to, an education or exhibition permit or an endangered or</u> 7 <u>threatened species license, authorizing the exhibition of a wild animal,</u> 8 <u>or elephant, in a circus, notwithstanding a valid United States depart-</u> 9 <u>ment of agriculture license.</u>

- 10 2. Such a prohibition shall not apply to:
- 11 <u>a. an accredited zoo accredited by the Association of Zoos and Aquari-</u> 12 <u>ums;</u>
- 13 b. a wildlife sanctuary.
- 14 § 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2020.
