AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to authorizing licensees to sell liquor and/or wine for off-premises consumption on Sundays

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 14 of section 105 of the alcoholic beverage control law, as amended by section 1 of part U of chapter 63 of the laws of 2003, is amended to read as follows:

2 (a) No premises licensed to sell liquor and/or wine for off-premises consumption shall be permitted to remain open:

3 (i) On Sunday before [~~twelve o'clock post meridian~~] ten o'clock antemeridian and after nine o'clock post meridian.

4 (ii) On any day between midnight and eight o'clock antemeridian.

5 (iii) On the twenty-fifth day of December, known as Christmas day.

6 In any community where daylight saving time is in effect, such time shall be deemed the standard time for the purpose of this subdivision.

7 § 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall have become a law.
