AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to requiring the metropolitan transportation authority to implement certain standards pertaining to applying and removing coatings from bridges, trestles, elevated subway and railway tracks and stations

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1266 of the public authorities law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 19 to read as follows:

  3 19. The authority shall require that all contractors and employees

- 7 the society for protective coatings painting contractor certification
- 8 program to standards QP-1, QP-2 and ACS-1. The application and removal
- 9 of all paint and coatings on authority property, facilities and assets
- 10 shall be performed in accordance with society for protective coatings
- 11 standards QP-1, QP-2 and ACS-1.
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
