AN ACT to amend chapter 108 of the laws of 2016, amending the vehicle and traffic law relating to authorizing a pilot residential parking permit system in the city of Buffalo, in relation to the effectiveness thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 3 of chapter 108 of the laws of 2016, amending the 2 vehicle and traffic law relating to authorizing a pilot residential 3 parking permit system in the city of Buffalo, is amended to read as follows:

§ 3. This act shall take effect immediately and shall remain in full force and effect for a period of [730 days] five years after the implementation of the local law or ordinance adopted by the city of Buffalo pursuant to section 1640-p of the vehicle and traffic law as added by section two of this act at which time this act shall expire and be 10 deemed repealed. The city of Buffalo shall notify the legislative bill 11 drafting commission upon the occurrence of such implementation or 12 adoption in order that the commission may maintain an accurate and time-13 ly effective data base of the official text of the laws of the state of 14 New York in furtherance of effectuating the provisions of section 44 of 15 the legislative law and section 70-b of the public officers law.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
