AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to establishing the hours during which alcoholic beverages may be sold on certain international airport property

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 5 of section 106 of the alcoholic beverage control law, as amended by chapter 83 of the laws of 3 1995, is amended to read as follows:

(b) On any other day between four ante meridiem and eight ante meridiem; provided, however, on premises located within an international airport owned or operated by the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey, on any other day between three ante meridiem and six ante meridiem.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
