AN ACT to grant Philip Fagan eligibility for permanent appointment as a police officer with the police department of the village of Highland Falls, in the county of Orange

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of section 58 of the civil service law to the contrary, the village of Highland Falls, in the country of Orange is hereby authorized and directed, upon approval of the police chief of the village of Highland Falls, to reinstate Philip Fagan, a part-time police officer employed by the village of Highland Falls, who previously received a permanent appointment in the competitive class of civil service as a police officer with the police department of the village of Harriman, in the country of Orange, to a full-time competitive position as a police officer with the police department of the village of Highland Falls.

11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
