AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to co-location of farms and renewable energy projects

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 309 of the agriculture and markets law is amended 2 by adding a new subdivision 10 to read as follows:

3 <u>10. a. The advisory council on agriculture shall study and provide</u> 4 <u>recommendations to the commissioner on best practices to allow for</u> 5 <u>co-location in an effort to enhance compatibility between renewable</u> 6 <u>energy development and the protection of natural and agricultural</u> 7 <u>resources. Such recommendations on best practices shall focus on renewa-</u> 8 <u>ble energy projects and their impact on the loss of prime agricultural</u> 9 <u>lands. Any findings and recommendations pursuant to this subdivision</u> 10 <u>shall be made available to the public, and may be included in the coun-</u> 11 <u>cil's report pursuant to subdivision seven of this section.</u>

12 b. "Co-location," as used in this section shall mean viable farmland 13 eligible for the deliberate production of farm products and renewable 14 energy in a single location.
