AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to increasing the maximum contribution under a defined contribution plan service award

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (b) of section 218 of the general municipal 2 law, as amended by chapter 452 of the laws of 2004, is amended to read 3 as follows:

(b) The sponsor of a defined contribution plan shall contribute to the plan a fixed amount of money, as determined by the sponsor, on behalf of each participant who is credited with a year of service. The minimum and maximum contribution requirements for a defined contribution service award program shall be as follows. The minimum contribution shall be one hundred twenty dollars per year of service. The maximum contribution shall be [seven] twenty-one hundred dollars per year of service. The maximum number of years of service for which a participant may receive a contribution shall be forty years. The sponsor shall appropriate annually an amount sufficient to pay the contributions.

14 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
