AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to including licensed municipal public safety officers on the list of public employees for which prevention of duties qualifies as assault in the second degree

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivisions 3 and 11 of section 120.05 of the penal law, subdivision 3 as amended by chapter 267 of the laws of 2016 and subdivision 11 as separately amended by chapters 268 and 281 of the laws of 2016, are amended to read as follows:

5 3. With intent to prevent a peace officer, a police officer, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the criminal 7 procedure law, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, public health sanitarian, New York city public health sanitarian, sanitation enforce-9 ment agent, New York city sanitation worker, a firefighter, including a 10 firefighter acting as a paramedic or emergency medical technician admin-11 istering first aid in the course of performance of duty as such fire-12 fighter, an emergency medical service paramedic or emergency medical 13 service technician, or medical or related personnel in a hospital emer-14 gency department, a city marshal, a school crossing guard appointed 15 pursuant to section two hundred eight-a of the general municipal law, a 16 traffic enforcement officer, traffic enforcement agent, licensed munici-17 pal public safety officer or employee of any entity governed by the 18 public service law in the course of performing an essential service, from performing a lawful duty, by means including releasing or failing 19 to control an animal under circumstances evincing the actor's intent 20 that the animal obstruct the lawful activity of such peace officer, 21 22 police officer, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of 23 section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law, registered nurse, licensed 24 practical nurse, public health sanitarian, New York city public health sanitarian, sanitation enforcement agent, New York city sanitation work-26 er, firefighter, paramedic, technician, city marshal, school crossing guard appointed pursuant to section two hundred eight-a of the general 27
