AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to inciting violence against an active duty member of the military or the reserves

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 240.12 to 2 read as follows:

§ 240.12 Inciting violence against an active duty member of the military or the reserves.

A person is guilty of inciting violence against an active duty member 6 of the military or the reserves when, with the intention of inciting or producing imminent violence against an active duty member of the New York guard, New York Naval militia, the United States army, navy, air 9 force, marines, coast quard, army national quard, air national quard 10 and/or the reserves thereof, he or she advocates violence against one or 11 more such persons that is likely to incite or produce such violence.

Inciting violence against an active duty member of the military or the 12 13 <u>reserves is a class D felony.</u>

14 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 15 have become a law.
