AN ACT to amend part BBB of chapter 59 of the laws of 2017 relating to establishing the county-wide shared services property tax savings law, in relation to adding public library systems to the list of countywide shared services property tax savings law

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph b of subdivision 5 of section 1 of part BBB of
chapter 59 of the laws of 2017, relating to establishing the county-wide
shared services property tax savings law, is amended to read as follows:
