AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to decriminalizing psilocybin

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraphs 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37 and 38 of subdivision (d) of schedule I of section 3306 of the public health law, paragraphs 19, 20, 21, 22, 23 and 24 as added by chapter 664 of the laws of 1985, paragraphs 25, 26, 27, 28, 29 and 30 as added by chapter 589 of the laws of 1996, paragraphs 31 5 and 32 as added by chapter 457 of the laws of 2006, paragraphs 33, 34 and 35 as added by chapter 370 of the laws of 2015 and paragraphs 36, 37 and 38 as added by section 5 of part BB of chapter 57 of the laws of 9 2018, are amended to read as follows:
