AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to prohibiting the charging of membership fees during a state disaster emergency

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 399-vv to read as follows:
- § 399-vv. Prohibition of membership fee charges. 1. During a state disaster emergency, declared pursuant to article 2-B of the executive law, no person, partnership, corporation, association or other business entity shall charge a consumer any contracted membership fee when, due to such state disaster emergency:
 - (a) the contracted service has ceased, partially or fully;
 - (b) the contracted service has been rendered impossible or illegal;
- 10 <u>(c) the non-use of a facility or premises, or the non-rendering or the</u>
 11 <u>non-use of a contracted service, has frustrated the purpose of the</u>
 12 <u>contract; or</u>
- 13 <u>(d) a consumer would experience and demonstrates financial hardship if</u> 14 <u>he or she were to pay such membership fee.</u>
- 2. Every violation of this section shall be punishable by a civil penalty not to exceed one thousand dollars.
- 17 3. Nothing in this section shall be construed to restrict any right which any person may have under any other statute or the common law.
- 19 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
