- Introduced by COMMITTEE ON RULES -- (at request of M. of A. Gunther, Paulin, Buttenschon, Mosley, Simon, Thiele, Englebright, Barrett, Jaffee, DiPietro, DeStefano, Finch, Crouch, Montesano, B. Miller) -read once and referred to the Committee on Agriculture
- AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to land used in agricultural production; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The opening paragraph and paragraphs f, h, k and l of 2 subdivision 4 of section 301 of the agriculture and markets law, the 3 opening paragraph as amended by chapter 344 of the laws of 2012, para-4 graph f as amended by chapter 445 of the laws of 2002, paragraph h as 5 amended by chapter 587 of the laws of 2005, paragraph k as added by 6 chapter 341 of the laws of 2008 and paragraph l as added by chapter 384 7 of the laws of 2011, are amended to read as follows:

8 "Land used in agricultural production" means not less than seven acres 9 of land used as a single operation in the preceding two years for the 10 production for sale of crops, livestock or livestock products of an average gross sales value of [ten] five thousand dollars or more; or, 11 12 not less than seven acres of land used in the preceding two years to 13 support a commercial horse boarding operation or a commercial equine 14 operation with annual gross receipts of [ten] five thousand dollars or 15 more. Land used in agricultural production shall not include land or portions thereof used for processing or retail merchandising of such 16 crops, livestock or livestock products. Land used in agricultural production shall also include: 17 18

19 f. Land of not less than seven acres used as a single operation in the 20 preceding two years for the production for sale of crops, livestock or 21 livestock products of an average gross sales value of [ten] <u>five</u> thou-22 sand dollars or more, or land of less than seven acres used as a single 23 operation in the preceding two years for the production for sale of 24 crops, livestock or livestock products of an average gross sales value 25 of [<u>fifty</u>] <u>twenty-five</u> thousand dollars or more.

EXPLANATION--Matter in <u>italics</u> (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [-] is old law to be omitted.

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1 h. Land that is owned or rented by a farm operation in its first or 2 second year of agricultural production, or, in the case of a commercial horse boarding operation in its first or second year of operation, that 3 4 consists of (1) not less than seven acres used as a single operation for 5 the production for sale of crops, livestock or livestock products of an annual gross sales value of [ten] five thousand dollars or more; or (2) б 7 less than seven acres used as a single operation for the production for 8 sale of crops, livestock or livestock products of an annual gross sales 9 value of [fifty] twenty-five thousand dollars or more; or (3) land situ-10 ated under a structure within which crops, livestock or livestock products are produced, provided that such crops, livestock or livestock 11 products have an annual gross sales value of (i) [ten] five thousand 12 13 dollars or more, if the farm operation uses seven or more acres in agri-14 cultural production, or (ii) [fifty] twenty-five thousand dollars or 15 more, if the farm operation uses less than seven acres in agricultural 16 production; or (4) not less than seven acres used as a single operation 17 to support a commercial horse boarding operation with annual gross 18 receipts of [ten] five thousand dollars or more.

19 k. Land used to support an apiary products operation which is owned by 20 the operation and consists of (i) not less than seven acres nor more 21 than ten acres used as a single operation in the preceding two years for the production for sale of crops, livestock or livestock products of an 22 average gross sales value of [ten] five thousand dollars or more or (ii) 23 24 less than seven acres used as a single operation in the preceding two 25 years for the production for sale of crops, livestock or livestock 26 products of an average gross sales value of [fifty] twenty-five thousand 27 dollars or more. The land used to support an apiary products operation 28 shall include, but not be limited to, the land under a structure within 29 which apiary products are produced, harvested and stored for sale; and a 30 buffer area maintained by the operation between the operation and adja-31 cent landowners. Notwithstanding any other provision of this subdivi-32 sion, rented land associated with an apiary products operation is not 33 eligible for an agricultural assessment based on this paragraph.

34 1. Land that is owned or rented by a farm operation in its first or 35 second year of agricultural production or in the case of a commercial 36 equine operation, in its first or second year of operation, that 37 consists of not less than seven acres and stabling at least ten horses, 38 regardless of ownership, that receives [ten] five thousand dollars or more in gross receipts annually from fees generated through the 39 provision of commercial equine activities including, but not limited to 40 41 riding lessons, trail riding activities or training of horses or through 42 the production for sale of crops, livestock, and livestock products, or 43 through both the provision of such commercial equine activities and such production. Under no circumstances shall this subdivision be construed 44 45 to include operations whose primary on site function is horse racing. 46 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be 47 deemed repealed two years after such date.

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
