AN ACT in relation to extending the date for school district and library
elections until June 16, 2020 as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law or Executive
2 Order No. 202.26 and as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, sections
3 1804, 1906, 2002, 2022, 2601-a of the education law, to the extent
4 necessary, to provide that the annual district meeting and election of
5 every common, union free, central and central high school district and
6 the annual meeting of every city school district in a city having a
7 population of less than one hundred twenty-five thousand inhabitants was
8 scheduled to be held on the third Tuesday of May, two thousand twenty is
9 hereby adjourned and rescheduled until June 16, 2020, which shall be
10 deemed the statewide uniform voting day; and provided further, a library
11 district may conduct an election on June 16, 2020 if such election is
12 managed by a school district.
13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
