AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to aggravated resisting arrest

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 205.35 to 2 read as follows:
- 3 § 205.35 Aggravated resisting arrest.
- A person is guilty of aggravated resisting arrest when such person intentionally prevents or attempts to prevent a police officer or peace officer from effecting an authorized arrest of such person or another person through the use of physical force, where such authorized arrest is for a crime which is a felony.
- 9 Aggravated resisting arrest is a class D felony.
- 10 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 11 have become a law.
