AN ACT to prohibit school districts from requiring annual professional performance reviews of classroom teachers and building principals during the 2020-2021 school year; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, school 1 2 districts shall not be required to complete annual professional perform-3 ance reviews of classroom teachers and building principals during the 4 2020-2021 school year due to the state disaster emergency declared 5 pursuant to executive order 202 of 2020 and any apportionment of funds for the general support of public schools for which a school district is б otherwise entitled shall not be withheld due to a school district not 7 8 submitting documentation to the commissioner of education demonstrating 9 that the school district has fully implemented the standards and proce-10 dures for conducting annual teacher and principal evaluations of teach-11 ers and principals in accordance with the requirements of section 3012-d 12 of the education law and the regulations issued by the commissioner of 13 education.

14 § 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a board of education 15 or the trustees of a common school district, only upon specific agreement, may appoint on tenure those classroom teachers and building prin-16 17 cipals recommended by the superintendent of schools who are in the final year of the probationary period, have received the previous requisite 18 annual professional performance review ratings pursuant to section 19 3012-d of the education law and would have been in their discretion 20 21 qualified for appointment on tenure based upon past performance, 22 notwithstanding that their annual professional performance review had 23 not been completed and they had not received the necessary effectiveness 24 rating for the 2020-2021 school year, or such board of education or 25 trustees of a common school district may extend such determination for 26 an additional year.

27 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be 28 deemed repealed June 30, 2021.
