AN ACT permitting New York residents to receive a coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) vaccine at no cost

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, once a vaccine for the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) is approved by the federal Food and Drug Administration and the New York state's clinical advisory task force, a person shall be eligible to receive a coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) vaccine at no cost, without regard to immigration status, if such person is a resident of New York state and ineligible to participate in any federal program to receive such vaccine at no cost.

- 9 § 2. Funding, within available appropriations, shall be provided for 10 administering a coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) vaccine pursuant to 11 section one of this act.
- 12 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
