AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to prohibiting a pedestrian from using a portable electronic device while crossing a roadway

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new section 1158 to read as follows:

- § 1158. Use of portable electronic devices. (a) No pedestrian shall cross a roadway at any point while using any portable electronic device.
- (b) For purposes of this section: 1. "Portable electronic device" shall mean any handheld mobile telephone, as defined by subdivision one of section twelve hundred twenty-five-c of this title, personal digital assistant (PDA), handheld device with mobile data access, laptop computer, pager, broadband personal communication device, two-way messaging device, electronic game, or portable computing device, or any other 10 electronic device when used to input, write, send, receive, or read text 12 <u>for present or future communication.</u>
- 2. "Using" shall mean holding a portable electronic device while view-14 ing, taking or transmitting images, playing games, or, for the purpose 15 of present or future communication: performing a command or request to access a world wide web page, composing, sending, reading, viewing, accessing, browsing, transmitting, saving or retrieving e-mail, text 18 messages, instant messages, or other electronic data.
- 19 (c) Subdivision (a) of this section shall not apply to: 1. the use of 20 a portable electronic device for the sole purpose of communicating with any of the following regarding an emergency situation: an emergency 21 response operator; a hospital; a physician's office or health clinic; an

ambulance company or corps; a fire department, district or company; or a police department; and

- 2. any of the following persons while in the performance of their official duties: a police officer or peace officer; a member of a fire department, district or company; or the operator of an authorized emergency vehicle as defined in section one hundred one of this chapter.
- 7 (d) A violation of this section shall be punishable by a fine of twen-8 ty-five dollars upon conviction of a first violation; upon conviction of 9 a second or subsequent violation, both of which were committed within a 10 period of eighteen months, such violations shall be punished by a fine

11 of fifty dollars.
