AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to the definition of person

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 125.05 of the penal law is amended 2 to read as follows:
- 1. "Person," when referring to the victim of a homicide, means a human
- 4 being who has been born and is alive. This provision shall be known as
- 5 <u>"Mya's law".</u>
- 6 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
