AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to providing for the observance of September 11th Remembrance Day and providing for the observance of a brief period of silence on such day

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 802 of the education law is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 2. <u>a.</u> It shall also be [his] the duty of the commissioner to make special provision for the observance in the public schools of Lincoln's birthday, Washington's birthday, Memorial day and Flag day, and such other legal holidays of like character as may be hereafter designated by law when the legislature makes an appropriation therefor.
- 8 <u>b. It shall also be the duty of the commissioner to make special</u>
 9 <u>provision for the observance of a brief period of silence for September</u>
 10 <u>11th Remembrance Day.</u>
- 11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
