AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to allowing bed and breakfasts to sell cider, liquor, beer and wine

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 51 of the alcoholic beverage 2 control law, as amended by chapter 431 of the laws of 2014, is amended to read as follows:

- 4. A licensed brewery may operate a restaurant, <u>a</u> hotel, <u>an establish-</u> 5 ment designated and commonly known and operated as a bed and breakfast, a catering establishment, or other food and drinking establishment in or adjacent to the licensed premises and sell at such place, at retail for consumption on the premises, beer manufactured by the licensee and any New York state labeled beer. All of the provisions of this chapter rela-10 tive to licenses to sell beer at retail for consumption on the premises shall apply so far as applicable to such licensee. Notwithstanding any 12 other provision of law, the licensed brewer may apply to the liquor 13 authority for a license to sell beer, wine or liquor at retail for 14 consumption on the premises at such establishment. All of the provisions 15 of this chapter relative to licenses to sell beer, wine or liquor at retail for consumption on the premises shall apply so far as applicable to such application.
- § 2. Paragraph (g) of subdivision 2 of section 51-a of the alcoholic 18 19 beverage control law, as amended by chapter 431 of the laws of 2014, is 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 (g) operate a restaurant, a hotel, an establishment designated and 22 commonly known and operated as a bed and breakfast, a catering establishment, or other food and drinking establishment in or adjacent to the 23 24 licensed premises and sell at such place, at retail for consumption on 25 the premises, beer and cider manufactured by the licensee and any New

- (ii) operate a restaurant, a hotel, an establishment designated and commonly known and operated as a bed and breakfast, a catering establishment, or other food and drinking establishment in or adjacent to the licensed premises and sell at such place, at retail for consumption on the premises, cider manufactured by the licensee and any New York state labeled cider. All of the provisions of this chapter relative to licensees to selling cider at retail shall apply. Notwithstanding any other 34 provision of law, the licensed farm cidery may apply to the authority for a license under this chapter to sell other alcoholic beverages at retail for consumption on the premises at such establishment;
 - § 5. Subparagraph (ii) of paragraph (e) of subdivision 2-c of section 61 of the alcoholic beverage control law, as amended by chapter 431 of the laws of 2014, is amended to read as follows:
 - operate a restaurant, a hotel, an establishment designated and commonly known and operated as a bed and breakfast, a catering establishment, or other food and drinking establishment in or adjacent to the licensed premises and sell at such place, at retail for consumption on the premises, liquor manufactured by the licensee and any New York state labeled liquor. All of the provisions of this chapter relative to licenses to sell liquor at retail for consumption on the premises shall apply so far as applicable to such licensee. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the licensee may apply to the authority for a license under this chapter to sell other alcoholic beverages at retail for consumption on the premises at such establishment.
- 51 § 6. Subdivision 5-a of section 64 of the alcoholic beverage control 52 law, as added by chapter 480 of the laws of 2003, is amended to read as 53 follows:
- 54 5-a. Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision five of this 55 section, a liquor license may be issued under this section to an establishment designated and commonly known and operated as a "bed and break-

fast" regardless of whether or not a restaurant is operated in such establishment[- provided that such lisense shall only permit the sale of alcoholic beverages to overnight guests of such establishment].

- § 7. Subdivision 4-a of section 76 of the alcoholic beverage control law, as amended by chapter 431 of the laws of 2014, is amended to read as follows:
- 4-a. A licensed winery may operate a restaurant, a hotel, an establishment designated and commonly known and operated as a bed and break**fast**, a catering establishment, or other food and drinking establishment in or adjacent to the licensed premises and sell at such place, at retail for consumption on the premises, wine and wine products manufactured by the licensee and any New York state labeled wine or New York state labeled wine product. All of the provisions of this chapter relative to licenses to sell wine at retail for consumption on the premises shall apply so far as applicable to such licensee. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the licensed winery may apply to the authority for a license under article four of this chapter to sell other alcoholic beverages at retail for consumption on the premises at such establishment.
- § 8. Subdivision 4-a of section 76 of the alcoholic beverage control law, as amended by chapter 522 of the laws of 2018, is amended to read as follows:

All of the provisions of this chapter relative to licenses to sell wine at retail for consumption on the premises shall apply so far as applicable to such licensee. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the licensed winery may apply to the authority for a license under article four of this chapter to sell other alcoholic beverages at retail for consumption on the premises at such establishment.
 - § 10. Paragraph (f) of subdivision 2 of section 76-a of the alcoholic beverage control law, as amended by chapter 522 of the laws of 2018, is amended to read as follows:
 - (f) operate a restaurant, a hotel, an establishment designated and commonly known and operated as a bed and breakfast, a catering estab-

lishment, or other food and drinking establishment in or adjacent to the licensed premises and sell at such place, at retail for consumption on the premises, wine, cider, and mead manufactured by the licensee and any New York state labeled wine, New York state labeled cider, New York state labeled mead or New York state labeled wine product. All of the provisions of this chapter relative to licenses to sell wine at retail for consumption on the premises shall apply so far as applicable to such licensee. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the licensed farm winery may apply to the authority for a license under this chapter to sell other alcoholic beverages at retail for consumption on the premises at such establishment.

- § 11. This act shall take effect immediately; provided however, that:
- 13 (a) the amendments to paragraph (g) of subdivision 2 of section 51-a 14 of the alcoholic beverage control law made by section three of this act 15 shall take effect on the same date and in the same manner as section 10 16 of chapter 522 of the laws of 2018, takes effect;
 - (b) the amendments to subdivision 4-a of section 76 of the alcoholic beverage control law made by section eight of this act shall take effect on the same date and in the same manner as section 18 of chapter 522 of the laws of 2018, takes effect; and
- 21 (c) the amendments to paragraph (f) of subdivision 2 of section 76-a 22 of the alcoholic beverage control law made by section ten of this act 23 shall take effect on the same date and in the same manner as section 21 24 of chapter 522 of the laws of 2018, takes effect.
- 25 Effective immediately the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any 26 rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its 27 effective date are authorized to be made and completed on or before such 28 date.
