AN ACT to authorize the assessor of the town of Haverstraw, county of Rockland, to accept from Hi Tor Animal Care Center, Inc. an application for exemption from real property taxes

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the assessor of the town of Haverstraw, county of Rockland, is hereby authorized to accept from Hi Tor Animal Care Center, Inc. an application for exemption from real property taxes pursuant to section 420-a of the real property tax law for the 2017 assessment roll, for the parcel owned by such organization located at 221 Ramapo Road, in the village of West Haverstraw within the town of Haverstraw, county of Rockland, otherwise known as Rockland county tax map, section 26.11, block 2, lot 58. If accepted, the application shall be reviewed as if it had been received on or before the taxable status date established for such rolls.

If satisfied that such organization would otherwise be entitled to such exemption if such organization had acquired the property and filed an application by the appropriate taxable status date, the assessor,
