AN ACT to amend chapter 504 of the laws of 2016, amending the tax law relating to authorizing the town of Greenburgh to adopt a local law to impose a hotel/motel occupancy tax for hotels not located in a village and authorizing specified villages in the towns of Greenburgh and Mount Pleasant to adopt local laws to imposed a hotel/motel occupancy tax in such villages, in relation to extending the effectiveness thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of chapter 504 of the laws of 2016, amending the
2 tax law relating to authorizing the town of Greenburgh to adopt a local
3 law to impose a hotel/motel occupancy tax for hotels not located in a
4 village and authorizing specified villages in the towns of Greenburgh
5 and Mount Pleasant to adopt local laws to impose a hotel/motel occupancy
6 tax in such villages, is amended to read as follows:
7 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately, and shall expire and be
8 deemed repealed September 1, [~~2019~~] 2022.
9 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately. Effective immediately,
10 the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary
11 for the implementation of this act on its effective date are
12 authorized to be made on or before such date.
