The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 33-1301 of the environmental conservation law is 2 amended by adding a new subdivision 12 to read as follows:
- 3 12. For any person to use chlorpyrifos.
- 4 § 2. This act shall take effect one year after it shall have become a 5 law.
