AN ACT to amend the elder law, in relation to eligibility under the program for elderly pharmaceutical insurance coverage

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 242 of the elder law is amended by adding a new paragraph (i) to read as follows:

(i) An individual who is determined to be eligible for assistance

 - § 2. This act shall take effect April 1, 2021.
