AN ACT to amend the town law and the public officers law, in relation to the residency requirement for the court attendant for the town of Somers, in the county of Westchester

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 23 of the town law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 33 to read as follows:

- 33. Notwithstanding subdivision one of this section, in the town of 4 Somers, in the county of Westchester, the provisions of this section requiring a person to be a resident of the political subdivision or municipal corporation of the state for which he or she shall be chosen or within which his or her official functions are required to be exercised, shall not prevent a person from holding the position of court attendant for the town of Somers, provided that such person resides in 10 the county in which such town is located. Provided, however, the person performing the functions of court attendant in any other town shall be a 11 resident of such town, unless otherwise provided by an act of the state <u>legislature.</u>
- 14 § 2. Section 3 of the public officers law is amended by adding a new 15 subdivision 68 to read as follows:
- 68. In the town of Somers, in the county of Westchester, the 16 provisions of this section requiring a person to be a resident of the 17 18 political subdivision or municipal corporation of the state for which he 19 or she shall be chosen or within which his or her official functions are 20 required to be exercised shall not prevent a person from holding the 21 position of court attendant for the town of Somers, provided that such person resides in the county in which such town is located. Provided, 22 however, the person performing the functions of court attendant in any
- 24 other town shall be a resident of such town, unless otherwise provided
- 25 by an act of the state legislature.
