AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to leave for cancer screening

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 159-b of the civil service law, as amended by chapter 465 of the laws of 2017, is amended to read as follows:

3 1. Every public officer, employee of this state, employee of any county, employee of any community college, employee of any public authority, employee of any public benefit corporation, employee of any board of cooperative educational services (BOCES), employee of any vocational education and extension board, or a school district enumerated in 7 section one of chapter five hundred sixty-six of the laws of nineteen 10 hundred sixty-seven, employee of any municipality, employee of any school district or any employee of a participating employer in the New York state and local employees' retirement system or any employee of a 12 participating employer in the New York state teachers' retirement system 13 shall be entitled to absent himself or herself and shall be deemed to 15 have a paid leave of absence from his or her duties or service as such public officer or employee of this state, employee of any county, 17 employee of any community college, employee of any public authority, employee of any public benefit corporation, employee of any board of 18 cooperative educational services (BOCES), employee of any vocational 19 20 education and extension board, or a school district enumerated in section one of chapter five hundred sixty-six of the laws of nineteen 22 hundred sixty-seven, employee of any municipality, employee of any school district, or any employee of a participating employer in the New 24 York state and local employees' retirement system or any employee of a 25 participating employer in the New York state teachers' retirement system
