AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring any person operating an aircraft to submit to a breathalyzer

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 2 241-a to read as follows:

§ 241-a. Breathalyzer requirement. Any person engaging within this state in operating aircraft shall be required to submit to a breathalyzer exam prior to operating such aircraft. Such breathalyzer exam shall occur prior to such individual boarding the aircraft. Any individual that provides a breath sample of .08 of one per centum or more by weight of alcohol in the person's blood shall not be permitted to operate such aircraft.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
