AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to the appointment of members of the public service commission

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of the public service law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 4 to read as follows:

3 4. Any commissioner appointed on or after July first, two thousand

4 <u>twenty</u>, <u>pursuant to this section shall have education and training</u>, <u>and</u> 5 <u>three or more years of experience in one or more of the following</u>

6 fields: economics, engineering, law, accounting, business management,

7 utility regulation, public policy, consumer advocacy or environmental

8 <u>management.</u>

9 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after 10 it shall have become a law.
