AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to watchers

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 8-500 of the election law, as 2 amended by chapter 254 of the laws of 2014, is amended to read as 3 follows:

- 4 4. Each watcher must be a qualified voter of the city or county in 5 which he or she is to serve. No person shall be appointed or act as a 6 watcher who is a candidate for any public office to be voted for by the 7 voters of the election district in the same election in which the watch-8 er is to serve. Nothing in this subdivision shall be construed as 9 prohibiting any such candidate from visiting a polling place in such district on an election day while the polls are open, or an attorney who is a New York state resident and is licensed to practice law therein.
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
