AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to prohibiting the metropolitan transportation authority from listing a gender on commuter tickets

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The public authorities law is amended by adding a new section 1266-1 to read as follows: <u>\$ 1266-1. Prohibition of gender information on commuter passes, tick-</u> tets or fare cards. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, the metropolitan transportation authority is prohibited from listing a gender on any commuter pass, ticket or fare card as a means of identifying the owner of such pass, ticket or fare card. § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
