AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring oil companies to clean up spillage occurring during a delivery

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 2 309 to read as follows:
- 2 309 to read as follows: § 309. Oil delivery spillage. Any spillage occurring in the course of
- 4 <u>oil delivery shall be cleaned up by the oil delivery company within</u> 5 <u>twenty-four hours. If the spill affects soil the clean up shall include</u>
- 6 replacing the affected soil with new soil. Violation of this section
- 7 shall result in a fine of five hundred dollars for the first offense and
- 8 <u>one thousand dollars for each additional offense, not to exceed ten</u>
 9 <u>thousand dollars payable by the oil delivery company.</u>
- 10 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 11 have become a law.
