AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to prohibiting the driving of motor vehicles or motorcycles in bicycle lanes or bicycle paths in a city with a population of one million or more

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new 2 section 1132 to read as follows:

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- § 1132. Driving in bicycle lanes or bicycle paths prohibited. Except 4 for emergency or fire vehicles, no person shall operate a motor vehicle or motorcycle in a bicycle lane or bicycle path in a city with a population of one million or more. The foregoing limitation shall not prevent motor vehicles from driving in bicycle lanes or bicycle paths when directed by police officers or flagpersons.
- 9 § 2. Subdivision (b) of section 1800 of the vehicle and traffic law is 10 amended by adding a new paragraph 3 to read as follows:
- 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph one of this subdivision, a person convicted of a traffic infraction for a violation of the 13 provisions of section eleven hundred thirty-two of this chapter shall
- 14 for conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than seventy-
- 15 five dollars and shall not be made part of the operating record of the
- 16 person upon whom such liability is imposed nor shall it be used for
- insurance purposes in the provision of motor vehicle insurance coverage. 17
- § 3. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 18 19 have become a law.
