AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in  
relation to requiring that no traffic-control signal shall indicate a  
green light for traffic while a pedestrian-control signal at such  
intersection displays a signal indicating walk for the pedestrian

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assem-  
bly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The administrative code of the city of New York is amended  
2 by adding a new section 19-196-a to read as follows:

3 § 19-196-a Pedestrian-control signals; timing. Any intersection with  
4 a pedestrian-control signal shall have such signal programmed to indi-  
5 cate that all pedestrians at the intersection shall cross the street at  
6 the same time. No traffic-control signal shall indicate a green light  
7 for traffic while a pedestrian-control signal at such intersection  
8 displays a signal indicating walk or a steady walking person.

9 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
