AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Sergeant Jeremy J. VanNostrand Memorial Highway"

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-i to read as follows:

3 § 344-i. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the 4 "Sergeant Jeremy J. VanNostrand Memorial Highway". The portion of state 5 route 5S in the town of Glen, county of Montgomery shall be designated 6 and known as the "Sergeant Jeremy J. VanNostrand Memorial Highway".

§ 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system 9 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid 10 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-11 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 12 ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be 13 changed as a result of this act.

14 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
