AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to designating uniformed court officers in the town of Busti, county of Chautauqua, as peace officers

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 2.10 of the criminal procedure law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 86 to read as follows:
- 86. Employees of the town of Busti, in the county of Chautauqua, serving as uniformed court officers in the justice court of such town;
  provided, however, that nothing in this subdivision shall be deemed to
  authorize such employees to carry, possess, repair or dispose of a
  firearm unless the appropriate license therefor has been issued pursuant
  to section 400.00 of the penal law.
- § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
