AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to establishing a data base of all firefighters

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 157-a
2 to read as follows:

3 § 157-a. Firefighters' data base. 1. The office of fire prevention and
4 control shall establish and maintain a centralized reporting system and
5 data base of the names and firefighting organizations of all firefight-
6 ers in the state.

7 2. Every fire department, fire company, fire district and any other
8 entity employing professional or volunteer firefighters shall submit to
9 the office of fire prevention and control a list of all officers and
10 inactive and active firefighting members, on or before January thirty-
11 first each year. Such list shall include such information and shall be
12 submitted in a form as determined by the state fire administrator.

13 3. For the purposes of this section an "active firefighting member"
14 shall be a firefighter who: (a) is a member of a firefighting organiza-
15 tion, (b) regularly participates in firefighting duties, (c) has
16 completed a basic firefighting course approved by the firefighting and
17 code enforcement personnel standards and education commission, and (d)
18 annually completes the fire safety training course as required by the
19 department of labor.

20 4. On or before March thirty-first each year, the office of fire
21 prevention and control shall submit a copy of all information contained
22 in the firefighters' data base to the governor, temporary president of
23 the senate, speaker of the assembly, minority leader of the senate and
24 the minority leader of the assembly.

EXPLANATION--Matter in italics (underscored) is new; matter in brackets

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1 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of December next succeed-
2 ing the date on which it shall have become a law. Effective immediate-
3 ly, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation
4 necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are
5 authorized to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
