AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to corrective remedies

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The criminal procedure law is amended by adding a new 2 section 240.46 to read as follows:

3 <u>§ 240.46 Corrective remedies.</u>

A violation of section 240.45 will entitle a party to a corrective remedy under subdivision one of section 240.70 only if the party's substantial rights are affected, and only to the extent required to cure the prejudice to those rights. A court shall not set aside a conviction, or reverse or modify a judgment, on account of a violation of section 240.45 unless the defendant demonstrates that his or her substantial rights are affected. 2 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
