AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to consecutive sentences for certain offenders; and to repeal certain provisions of the penal law, relating thereto

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 70.25 of the penal law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 6 to read as follows:
- 6. When a person is convicted of a crime committed while in the custody of a correctional facility or local correctional facility, any
 sentence of imprisonment imposed for such conviction shall run consectutively to any undischarged term of imprisonment to which the defendant
 was subject and for which he or she was confined at the time of the
 conviction.
- 9 § 2. Paragraphs (b) and (c) of subdivision 5 of section 70.25 of the 10 penal law, paragraph (b) as added by chapter 372 of the laws of 1981, 11 are REPEALED.
- 12 § 3. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-13 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
