AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system in Oneida county as the "Officer Kevin F. Crossley Memorial Highway"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-k to read as follows:

§ 344-k. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the "Officer Kevin F. Crossley Memorial Highway". All that portion of the 5 <u>highway system constituting Oriskany Boulevard (route sixty-nine) within</u> 6 the village of Whitesboro in the county of Oneida shall be designated and known as the "Officer Kevin F. Crossley Memorial Highway".

- § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system 10 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-12 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be changed as a result of this act. 14
- § 3. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 15 16 have become a law.
