AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to exemption from participation in work activities for applicants or recipients of public assistance; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (d) of subdivision 1 of section 332 of the social services law, as amended by section 148 of part B of chapter 436 of the laws of 1997, is amended to read as follows:

(d) a parent or other relative of a child who is personally providing
care for such child under one year of age for a [maximum] period of
twelve months[, only three months of which shall be attributable to any
one child, except as otherwise extended up to the twelve month period by
the social services official];

9 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be 10 deemed repealed July 31, 2021.
