AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to the creation by each social services district of a homeless housing task force

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The social services law is amended by adding a new section 2 50-a to read as follows:
- 3 § 50-a. Homeless housing task force. 1. Each social services district 4 in the state shall create a homeless housing task force to develop a
- ten-year homeless housing plan addressing short-term and long-term housing for homeless persons. Such plan shall include guidelines for emer-
- gency shelters; short-term housing; temporary encampments; supportive 8 housing for chronically homeless persons; long-term housing; standards
- 9 for health and safety; and public notice regarding location of facili-10 <u>ties.</u>
- 2. Membership on the task force shall include representatives of the 11
- 12 counties, cities, towns, housing authorities, civil and faith organiza-13 tions, schools, community networks, human services providers, law
- enforcement personnel, substance abuse treatment providers, mental 14
- health care providers, emergency health care providers, businesses, 15
- at-large representatives of the community, and a homeless or formerly 16 homeless individual. 17
- 3. Any plan and quidelines developed by a social services district 18 19 homeless housing task force shall be consistent with regulations appli-
- 20 cable to projects promulgated pursuant to title one of this article. 21
- 4. Each district homeless housing task force shall make recommenda-22 tions based on the plan and quidelines regarding the allocation of funds
- 23 received from any public or private source.

EXPLANATION -- Matter in italics (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [-] is old law to be omitted.

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- § 2. Paragraphs (c) and (d) of subdivision 2 of section 50 of the social services law, as amended by chapter 204 of the laws of 1998, are amended and a new paragraph (e) is added to read as follows:
- (c) a description of the manner in which coordination with other federal, state, local and privately funded services will be achieved; [and]
- (d) a description of how the services will be designed to assist households transition from a reliance on outside interventions and move toward housing stability and economic self reliance [-]; and
- 10 <u>(e) a copy of the ten-year plan and guidelines developed by a social</u>
  11 <u>services district homeless task force established pursuant to section</u>
  12 <u>fifty-a of this title.</u>
- § 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are authorized to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
