Introduced by M. of A. RAIA, STERN -- read once and referred to the Committee on Real Property Taxation

AN ACT to authorize the East Northport Fire Department to receive retro-active real property tax exempt status

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
2 the assessor of the county of Suffolk is hereby authorized to accept
3 from the East Northport Fire Department an application for exemption
4 from real property taxes pursuant to subdivision 2 of section 464 of the
5 real property tax law, with respect to the 2017-2018 assessment roll for
6 a portion of the 2017-2018 school taxes and all of the 2018 general
7 taxes and a portion of the 2017 general taxes, for the parcel conveyed
8 to such organization located at 206 Laurel Road, East Northport, town of
9 Huntington, county of Suffolk, otherwise known as Suffolk county parcel
10 ID district 0400 section 058.00 block 02.00 lot 072.000 and district
11 0400 section 058.00 block 02.00 lot 071.000. If accepted, the applica-
12 tion shall be reviewed as if it had been received on or before the taxa-
13 ble status date established for such roll.

14 If satisfied that such organization would otherwise be entitled to
15 such exemption if such organization had filed an application for
16 exemption by the appropriate taxable status date, the assessor, upon
17 approval by the Suffolk county legislature, may make appropriate
18 correction to the subject rolls. If such exemption is granted and such
19 organization, therefore, shall have paid any tax with respect to the
20 subject rolls, the applicable governing body or tax department may, in
21 its sole discretion, provide for the refund of those taxes paid and
22 cancel those taxes, fines, penalties, liens or interest remaining
23 unpaid.

24 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
