AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to the availability of buprenorphine in opioid treatment programs

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new section 2 32.12 to read as follows:
- 3 § 32.12 Availability of buprenorphine.
- Any provider of services or facility providing chemical dependence services shall have buprenorphine available to be administered to addicts. Such controlled substance shall be administered by a physician or group of physicians pursuant to subdivision (b) of section 32.05 of this article.
- § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are authorized to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
