AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to a driver's license issued to a person granted federal temporary protected status

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new 2 section 502-b to read as follows:

 3 § 502-b. Temporary protected status beneficiary licensing. 1.
 4 Prevention of license suspension. Notwithstanding any other provision
- of law, the department shall not cancel, suspend or rescind the driver's license, learner's permit, or non-driver identification card issued to
- 7 an individual granted federal temporary protected status if the federal
- 8 government ends the designation of temporary protected status for such individual's country of origin.
- 10 2. Application for license. Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 11 law, such department shall allow an individual who was formerly granted
- 12 temporary protected status to apply for or renew such individual's
- 13 driver's license, learner's permit, or non-driver identification card if
- 14 such individual meets all requirements other than the requirements
- 15 <u>related to immigration status.</u>
- 16 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
