AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to increased penalties for falsely reporting a hate crime

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 240.55 of the penal law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 4 to read as follows:
- 4. Alleges in such reporting that a hate crime occurred against a person based on race, color, national origin, ancestry, gender, gender identity or expression, religion, religious practice, age, disability or sexual orientation pursuant to section 485.05 of this chapter.
- 7 § 2. Section 485.05 of the penal law is amended by adding a new subdi-8 vision 1-a to read as follows:
- 9 <u>1-a. A person commits falsely reporting an incident in the second</u>
 10 <u>degree as defined in section 240.55 of the penal law, when, knowing the</u>
 11 <u>information reported, conveyed or circulated to be false or baseless, he</u>
 12 <u>or she alleges that a hate crime occurred pursuant to this section.</u>
- 3 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
