AN ACT in relation to penalties for striking a pedestrian crossing a street while operating a motor vehicle

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The commissioner of the department of motor vehicles is hereby directed to amend and/or adopt rules and regulations to provide that any person who is convicted or enters a guilty plea of violating section 1151 and/or 1151-a of the vehicle and traffic law shall receive points on his or her driving record.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
