AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to the eligibility requirements for a license in the practice of barbering

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 1 of section 434 of the general  
2 business law, as amended by chapter 469 of the laws of 2008, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 (b) Satisfactory evidence of good moral character [~~except that in~~  
5 ~~determining an applicant's good moral character, the secretary of state~~  
6 ~~shall not automatically disqualify an applicant on the basis of a criminal~~  
7 ~~conviction. The secretary shall review such criminal history information~~  
8 ~~in accordance with article twenty-three-A of the correction law~~];

9 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
