AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to the eligibility requirements for a license in the practice of barbering

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 1 of section 434 of the general business law, as amended by chapter 469 of the laws of 2008, is amended to read as follows:

(b) Satisfactory evidence of good moral character[-, except that in
determining an applicant's good moral character, the secretary of state
shall not automatically disqualify an applicant on the basis of a criminal conviction. The secretary shall review such criminal history infor-

8 mation in accordance with article twenty-three-A of the correction law];

9 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
